

CONTINUING EDUCATION IN EYE CARE 2010

Our second seminar series for this year will feature the following topics: *Cataract Surgery Masterclass* and *Cornea: Latest Techniques and Treatments*. Both topics will be presented on a number of occasions and at different venues, giving practitioners the opportunity to attend at a convenient time and location. Please note that there will be some minor variations as the presenters will use their own cases to illustrate key clinical points.



Cataract Surgery Masterclass

Patient expectations of the visual outcome from cataract surgery are very high nowadays, leading surgeons to continue optimising their assessment techniques and surgical procedure in order to best meet the patient's lifestyle requirements.

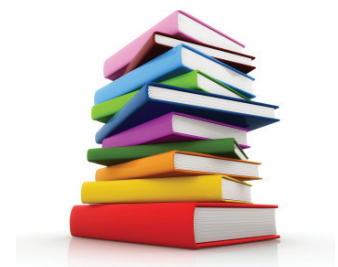


This presentation will review the critical steps of advanced ocular biometry and micro incision phaco-emulsification surgery that can help to reduce the likelihood of significant residual astigmatism or 'refractive surprise'.

Additionally, the rationale for deciding between using monofocal IOLs or multifocal or accommodating IOLs will be described. The application of toric IOLs will also be discussed.

Cornea: Latest Techniques & Treatments*

The presentations will discuss innovations in the surgical and therapeutic management of corneal disorders, including the collagen cross-linking treatment and the intra-corneal ring inserts for keratoconus patients, and new approaches to managing dry eye, pterygium, and corneal transplantation. The risks and outcomes for these procedure will be outlined. Optometric referral indications and the post-operative management will also be discussed.
